Pray in the Church – Thanks to our volunteer stewards, Holy Redeemer is open daily: Monday to Saturday 10.00am to 11.00am, Sunday 10.00am to 12.00midday. Please wear a face covering in church and remember to use the hand sanitizer provided, as well as following the one way system to enter and leave the church.

Cardinal Vincent Nichols – Please remember Cardinal Vincent in your prayers. Sunday was his seventy-fifth birthday and he therefore sent his resignation to Pope Francis. However, the Holy Father has asked him to stay on as Archbishop of Westminster for the time being.

Mass on the Internet - Many parishioners have told me how much they have appreciated being able to follow Mass being live streamed from various churches, including Westminster Cathedral. If you want details of churches which are live streaming Mass, churchservices.tv is a good place to look.

Helping - Some parishioners have been asking how they can help or seeking information on charities helping the homeless people on our streets.
