The Ultra- Low Emission Zone (ULEZ) is expanding from 25th October to create a larger zone, up to (but not including) the North Circular Road (A406) and South Circular Road (A205). This is part of the commitment by the Mayor and TfL to help every Londoner breathe cleaner air. Four out of five cars already meet the ULEZ emissions standards, but we owners of the remaining polluting cars need to take action.
