21 November : Christ The King

Monday: St Cecilia, Martyr, Patron Saint of music and musicians.

Tuesday: St Clement, Pope and Martyr

Wednesday: St Andrew Dũng-Lạc, Priest, and Companions, Martyrs

Thursday: St Catherine of Alexandria, Virgin and Martyr. She is often depicted with or on the wheel that was the instrument of her torture, though finally she was executed by being beheaded. This was at the orders of the Emperor Maxentius, after he had failed to persuade or threaten her to abandon her Christian faith. Not only had he failed, but she had defeated in debate the philosophers the Emperor had summoned to find any way to convince her to renounce Christ.
