Sunday 10th February: 5th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (Parish Mass Book page 136)

Monday 10th Our Lady of Lourdes, in 1858 the Virgin Mary appeared on a number of occasions to a poor local girl, Bernadette Soubirous. Now, near the Grotto of the Apparitions, pilgrims can bathe in water flowing from a spring. Lourdes is a town in southwestern France in the foothills of the Pyrenees mountains. Each year millions come as pilgrims to the beautiful shrine, which you can see live on www.lourdes-france.org/en/tv-lourdes/.

Thursday 14th St Cyril and St Methodius, two of the patron saints of Europe. Saints Cyril, a monk, and his brother Methodius, a bishop, were two Byzantine Christian theologians and missionaries. Through their work they influenced the cultural development of all Slavs, for which they received the title "Apostles to the Slavs". St Cyril developed the Cyrillic alphabet, used to this day by a number of Slav languages.

Thursday 14th St Valentine, a 3rd-century Roman saint who since the Middle Ages is associated with a tradition of courtly love. He was a priest who was executed for ministering to Christians being persecuted for their faith.
