

19th MARCH: ST JOSEPH

St Joseph was a man of compassion. When he discovered Mary was pregnant after they had been betrothed, he knew the child was not his, but was still unaware that she was carrying the Son of God. Women accused of adultery could be stoned to death, so he resolved to send her away quietly so as not to expose her to shame or cruelty. Then an angel came to Joseph in a dream and told him not be afraid to take Mary home as his wife, because what was conceived in her was from the Holy Spirit. Mary was to give birth to a son, to be named Jesus, because he was to save his people from their sins. He did as the angel told him and took Mary as his wife. (Matthew 1.19-25).

LENTEN ALMS

During Lent, in addition to the CAFOD Family Fast Day on Friday 15th March, the Diocese of Westminster has an ongoing campaign, the Cardinal's Lenten Appeal. The Cardinal's Lenten Appeal funds initiatives in parishes, schools and charities in the three mission areas of: **Marriage and Family Life**, enriching and supporting marriages, the essential building block of society and the Church; **Youth and Evangelisation**, supporting young people, the future of the Church, as they grow in their relationship with God and deepen their Catholic faith; and the **Church's Service in Society**, putting our faith into action by serving the poor, the lonely and the marginalised. This year, the Cardinal is asking us to think about the last of these in particular, and he has launched a new programme focusing on the food poverty that affects so many across the Diocese. Much of this poverty remains hidden. Many use foodbanks even though there is a wage earner in the family. In the words of Cardinal Nichols: "I hope this Appeal offers you and your family one way in which to observe Lent and to grow in the richness of our response to God's blessings of life and faith."
