

Sunday 5th May: THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER
(Parish Mass Book page 266)

The month of May is traditionally a time when we focus on the role of Mary in our salvation, turning to her as intercessor on our behalf. As the Second Vatican Council decreed: “(Mary) is a mother to us in the order of grace. This motherhood continues uninterruptedly from the consent which she loyally gave at the Annunciation and which she sustained without wavering beneath the cross... Taken up into heaven she did not lay aside this saving office but by her manifold intercession continues to bring us the gifts of eternal salvation.” (*Lumen Gentium* nn 61 – 62)
