Sunday 2nd June: SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

(Parish Mass Book page 281)

Monday 3rd June: St Charles Lwanga and Companions. In 1886, at the age of sixteen, the recently baptised Charles was threatened with death unless he renounce Christianity. However, along with a group of other young Ugandan Christians he remained faithful to Christ and endured being burned alive as a martyr. With his last words he asked his executioner to become a Christian.

Wednesday 5th June: St Boniface, born at Crediton, in Devon, this missionary known as "the Apostle of Germany" is famous for having challenged those who were worshipping trees, to worship, not the creation, but the Creator. This Archbishop of Mainz was martyred in 754 in Frisia.

Thursday 6th June: St Norbert was a young man who enjoyed the pleasures of life at the royal court, but underwent a conversion. Falling from his horse, startled by a storm, he was knocked unconscious. When he awoke his first words were, "Lord, what do you want me to do?": the same words Saul spoke on the road to Damascus. In response Norbert heard in his heart, "Turn from evil and do good. Seek peace and pursue it." Changing his ways, he sought to bring others to do likewise and was made bishop of Magdeburg.
